**SUBJECT:** Solar Collector Installation Guideline Policy for Treyburn Homeowners

The General Assembly of North Carolina approved Senate Bill 670 from Session Law 2007-279 regarding the installation of solar collectors for detached single-family residences effective October 1, 2007.

The guideline policy for the installation of solar collectors in the Treyburn Residential Community (TROA) is:


**Solar collectors shall not be installed if they are visible on the house's facade or slope of roof that faces any area open to common or public access. Any other location not visible from the street or common areas requires a review by the Modifications Committee.**

**Approval of Treyburn Modifications Committee is required prior to any solar collector installation.**
